On Sunday, from midnight to 11:59 p.m., all one-way trips of 30 minutes or less will be offered free of charge at the pay stations of 460 BIXI stations in Montreal, Longueuil and Westmount, according to the regular rental conditions. Additional fees will apply for any trips exceeding 30 minutes and a deposit of \$20 will temporarily be held on the credit card used to rent the bike for each trip taken.

Starting at 11 a.m. on Sunday, Manulife valets will be on site at Parc Lafontaine and at 40 stations around the city to help you rent a bike, provide information on the promotion and distribute healthy snack bags, offered courtesy of Rachelle-Béry (while quantities last). Maps of the network will also be given out on site. Additionally, 100 lucky Bixists will find a free one-year BIXI membership in their snack bag, courtesy of Manulife.
